

Seashore Campsites Rules and Regulations

- 1. Quiet Time – 11PM – 8AM** – This is a family environment, campers are asked to be considerate of others by keeping loud noises or other behaviors that would disturb their neighbors to a minimum. All audio volume must be turned down during quiet hours. All minors (18 years of age and under) must be on their site and under direct adult supervision by 11PM.
- 2. Speed Limit – 5MPH** – For the safety of everyone, especially children, the speed of all vehicles should not exceed 5MPH.
- 3. Age** – To rent a site you must be 21 years or older.
- 4. Golf Carts** – Allowed for Seasonal Site Holders **ONLY!** Golf Carts must be registered in the office. You are required to display the provided permit sticker along side your 3-inch site identification number. All persons operating a Golf Cart ***must have a valid Driver's License***. The number of passengers is limited to the number of seats in the Golf Car – NO exceptions. Golf Carts are to be operated in a safe and responsible manner. **See Golf Cart Agreement Form**
- 5. Campfires** – Live trees are NOT to be cut for any reason. All campfires must be contained in the supplied fire ring, and no higher than 24 inches high, as per the Fire Marshal. Campers may NOT burn trash or leaves. ***Campfires are never to be left unattended and must be completely extinguished*** before leaving the Campground or retiring for the evening.
- 6. Alcohol Policy** – In keeping with the family environment, no public intoxication is permitted. Violators will be requested to leave the Campground

and risk termination of their contract. Alcohol or smoking is NOT permitted in any Campground Facilities. Operating a moving vehicle while under the influence of drugs or alcohol is illegal and will be treated as such.

- 7. Pets** – All pets must be kept on a leash (no longer than 6 feet) and under control of the pet owner at all times. Please pick up and dispose of all pet droppings immediately. *Pets are not to be left unattended.* Pets are not permitted in any public buildings or swimming areas except service animals. If any pet becomes annoying, bothersome or in any way a nuisance to other campers, that pet must be removed from the premises immediately upon the Management’s Request. Seashore Campsites assumes no liability, implied or otherwise, for animal bites or injury. Shot records must be present. Use common sense when approaching wild animals.
- 8. Parental Responsibility** – Please provide continuous adult supervision for your children while in the Campground. Children 16 years of age and under must have adult supervision while in the Pool or Lake area. Parents will be held responsible for the actions of minors. All minors (18 years of age and under) must be on their site and under direct adult supervision by 11:00 PM.
- 9. Guests** – Campers may have Guests – people not registered on your seasonal contract or when you arrive – visit them, however the *Site Holder* must register them in the office. They are subject to applicable Guest Fees (daily \$5, overnight \$8) and car

passes obtained should be displayed at all times. Campers are responsible for the behaviors of their Guests. No more than 4 adults and 4 children on a site at any one time.

- 10. Swimming Pool / Lake** – Rules when utilizing our swimming facilities:
 - A. All babies/toddlers *must wear swim diapers* – The wearing of regular diapers is not permitted in either the Lake or the Pool.
 - B. The Lake will be closed when no Lifeguard is present. The pool may be utilized when no Lifeguard is present, however, you swim at your own risk. Never swim alone.
 - C. An adult must accompany all children 16 years of age and under while at the Pool or Lake.
 - D. Observe all signs posted.
 - E. Proper attire required.
 - F. No alcohol in Pool or Lake area.
 - G. No glass allowed in the Pool or Lake area.
- 11. Bicycle Riding** – Please remember all must share the roads. Use caution while riding in congested areas, especially around the store/entrance area. Helmets are mandated by the State of NJ and the Campground will not be held responsible for injury if one is not worn. All bikes must have proper safety lighting when riding after dark. Inexperienced riders should be accompanied by an adult. Ride at your own risk.
- 12. Trees** – It is in the best interest of the Campground to leave it in its natural state whenever possible. Cutting, trimming, or damaging trees or shrubbery is forbidden. Temporary clotheslines may

be strung from mature trees only, but for the safety of others please remove clothesline at dusk. As a seasonal camper you may request a tree to be removed by utilizing the following procedure:

- A. Complete a request for service in the office and indicate the location of the tree you would like removed.
- B. A staff member will assess the tree and approve or deny the request.

If the decision is made to remove the tree we will take one of the following two actions: If our staff is able to remove the tree safely we will precede accordingly. As a courtesy, the site occupant will not be charged for the removal of the tree. If our staff is not able to safely remove it we will secure bids from authorized tree removal specialists. We will schedule the removal of the tree with the company chosen and the site occupant will be charged accordingly. If a tree requires removal and/or trimming due to disease or storm damage the site occupant will not be charged. Under no circumstances should you remove the tree yourself or hire someone else to remove it. ***Any and all tree removal must be pre-approved by the office.***

13. **Trash Pick-Up** – Please dispose of all trash in the trash cans provided. Do not dispose of hazardous materials in trash containers. Do not burn trash in your campfire or bring trash from home. ***Recycling is mandatory*** in the Campground. Please place all recycled glass, cans, and plastic milk, water and soda bottles in a clear bag alongside the regular trashcans. Paper products should be bundled or placed in a paper bag near the regular trashcans. Pick up occurs daily.

All bulk trash, such as grills, televisions, bikes, refrigerators, lumber and carpets must be taken off of the premises for disposal.

14. **Sewer Connections and Gray Water** – A sewer donut is required around your sewer hose at the point of connection to the sewer pipe. Dumping of gray water or sewage onto the ground is prohibited. Any violation will result in a notice to take corrective action.
15. **Photography** – Commercial photography and filming is often conducted at Seashore Campsites. You may appear in pictures or film that may be used in advertising, news reporting, public relations, or other activities regarding the Campground. Your presence on the property constitutes your consent for Seashore Campsites to use any picture or films it deems appropriate without payment, inspection, or review.
